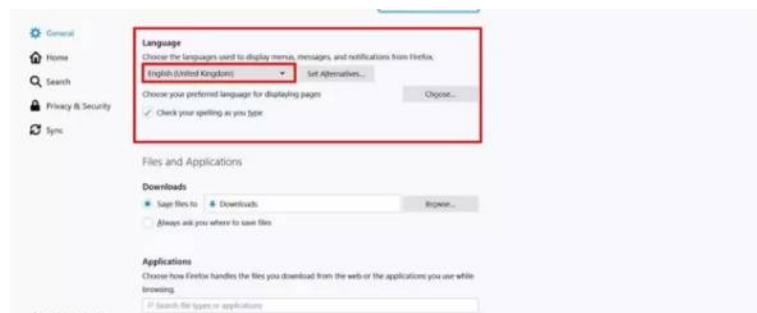


# Create a wordpress website using wordpress.com

WordPress.com is a user-friendly platform for creating websites and blogs without the need for advanced technical skills. Here's a step-by-step guide on how to create a WordPress website using WordPress.com:



## 1. Change your interface to english

- **Firefox** Switch to another language
- You can switch languages at any time to display Firefox menus, notifications, and messages in a different language.
- Click the menu button  and select **Settings**.
- In the Language section of the General panel, choose a language in the drop-down menu.



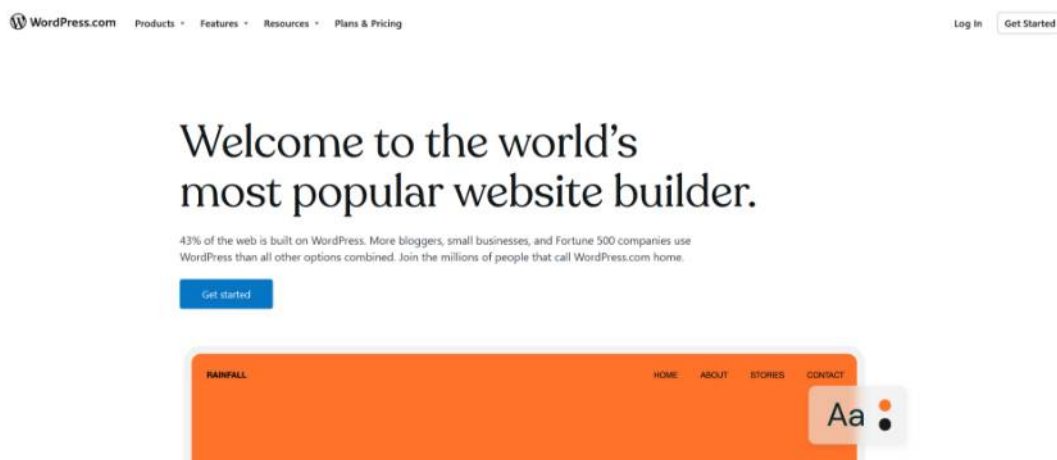
- Restart Firefox.

## Chrome Switch to another language

- If the language isn't listed, add it by clicking **Add languages**.
- Click **Display Google Chrome in this language**.
  - This option is only available on Windows computers.
- Restart Chrome to apply the changes.

## 2. Sign Up for a WordPress.com Account:

- Go to the WordPress.com website (<https://wordpress.com/>).
- Click the "Get Started" or "Start Your Website" button.

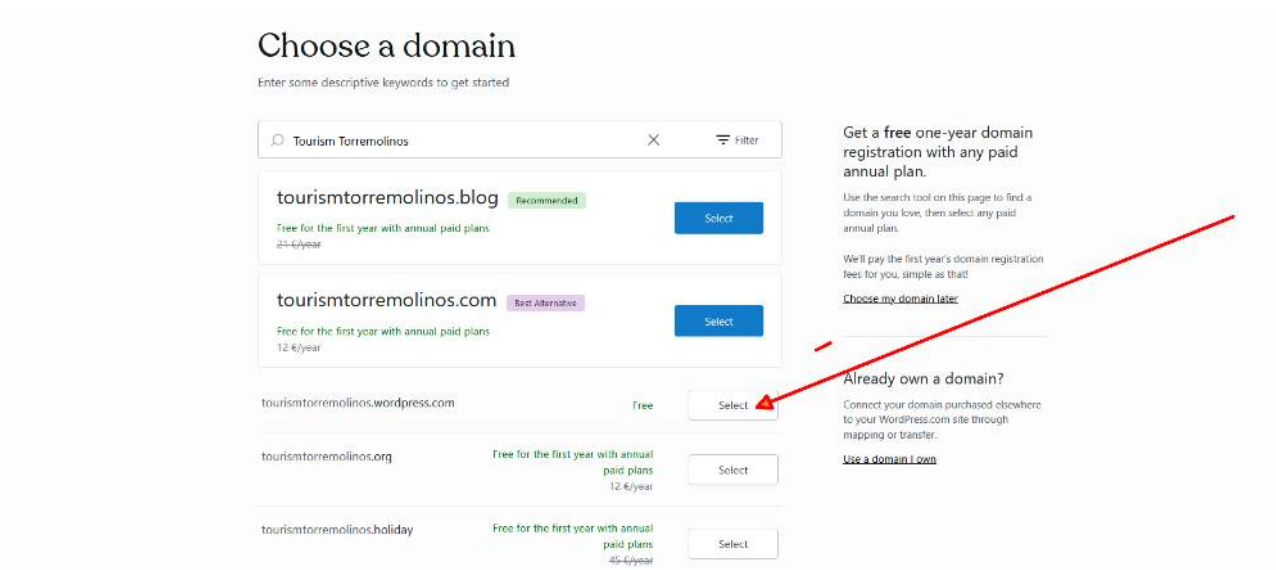


## 3. Choose a Plan:

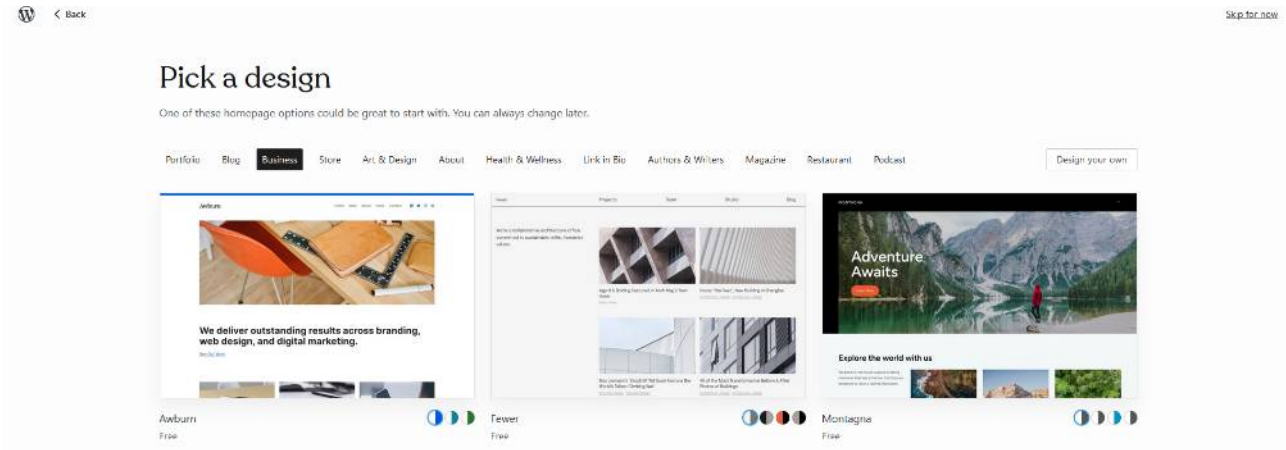

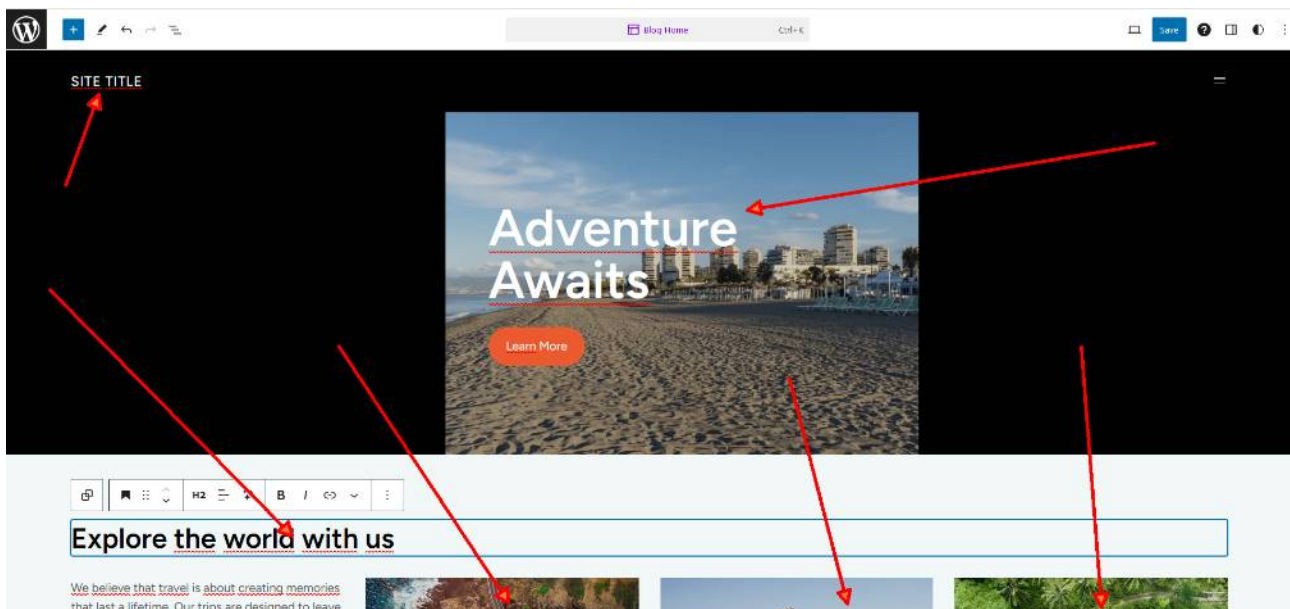
## 7. Select a Theme:
